

Notification of the personal data breach to the data subject (Article 34 of the Regulation)

In the event of a personal data breach likely to lead to a high risk to the rights and freedoms of individuals, HOLLEN notify the data subject of the personal data breach without undue delay.

The notification to the data subject shall contain a clear and simple description of the nature of the breach and at least the following information and measures:

- Name and contact details of the responsible person or other contact point where more information can be obtained
- A description of the likely consequences of the personal data breach
- A description of the measures taken or proposed by the controller to remedy the personal data breach, including measures to mitigate its potential adverse effects, if necessary.

This notification is not required if:

- HOLLEN take appropriate technical and organizational safeguards and apply them to the personal data affected by the privacy breach
- HOLLEN take follow-up measures to ensure that the high risk for the rights and freedoms of the data subjects is unlikely to have consequences
- This would require a disproportionate effort (in which case HOLLEN will inform the public or take other measures to ensure that the data subject is informed in the same effective way).
